Circular Economy – “Closing the Loop”

EU Action Plan, including new plastic strategy

“Win-win situation”

- Savings of €600 billion for EU businesses, equivalent to 8% of their annual turnover
- Creation of 580,000 jobs
- Reduction of EU carbon emissions by 450 million tonnes by 2030





Biggest GLOBAL ISSUES ACCORDING TO MILLENIALS



1. Climate change and destruction of natural resources (45.2%)
2. Large scale conflict and wars (38.5%)
3. Religious conflicts (33.8%)
4. Poverty (31.1%)
5. Government accountability and transparency, and corruption (21.7%)
6. Safety, security, and well being (18.1%)
7. Lack of education (16.5%)
8. Lack of political freedom and political instability (15.5%)
9. Food and water security (15.1%)
10. Lack of economic opportunity and unemployment (14.2%)
