PSBB Transition Extension Until January 3rd 2021 and Rates for Rapid Antigen Test

The DKI Jakarta Provincial Government has again extended the Large Scale Social Restrictions (PSBB) for the transition period until January 3rd 2021. DKI Jakarta Governor Anies Baswedan said the policy of extending the PSBB was carried out in order to control the mobility during the Christmas and New Year holidays which had a potential spike in Covid-19 cases.

In accordance with the decisions taken at the Covid-19 Handling Coordination Meeting in DKI Jakarta, West Java, Central Java, East Java and Bali virtually at the Coordinating Ministry for Maritime and Investment Office led by the Minister Luhut B. Pandjaitan. Entering and/or Exiting DKI Jakarta starting December 18th 2020, must carrying a letter of the Rapid Antigen Test result. The requirement for the Rapid Antigen Test applies to all public transportation users, including air, sea and land transportation. While priority will be carried out for the air transportation. This policy is valid until January 8th 2021.

Further, in case of train, the Rapid Antigen Test result only applies for long-distanced train (KAI) not for commuter line (KCI). Commuter line that connects Jabodetabek area applies body temperature check and face shield distribution for the passengers apart from mandatory to wear mask.

As the Rapid Antigen Test becoming one of the condition to travel, the costs are variative and tend to be expensive (IDR 300,000 -IDR 500,000). Responding to the variation in the price of the Rapid Antigen Test, the Indonesian Ministry of Health has set the highest rate for the Rapid Antigen Test IDR 250,000 in Java and IDR 275,000 outside Java. These rates do not apply to health facilities that receive aid from the government, it includes PPE or reagents. The tariff applies to people who wish to carry out Rapid Antigen Test by themselves as carried in Ministry of Health Circular Letter No. HK.02.02/1/4611/2020.
