## Updates on Vaccination Registration for Expatriates in Jakarta

On June 29, 2021, the Jakarta Deputy Governor (Wakil Gubernur), Ahmad Riza Patria, stated that expatriates aged 18 years and over can participate in the vaccination program in Jakarta. His statement is referring to the Minister of Health Regulation Number 18 Year 2021 concerning the Amendments to the Regulation of the Minister of Health Number 10 Year 2021 concerning the Implementation of Vaccination in the Context of Combating the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (Covid-19) Pandemic. The regulation inArticle 10A Paragraph (1) stated that expatriates are allowed to participate in Indonesia's covid-19 vaccination program. Please check the regulation in the link here

The criteria of expatriates who could get the vaccination are:

- Teacher
- Lecturers
- Education staff/supports who work at formal and informal schools or universities.
- Diplomat, through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Indonesia
- Elderly (60 years old and over)
- Live in the vulnerable RT/RWs areas as follow;
- 1. 445 RWs stated in Governor's Regulation No. 90 Year 2018, please check the link here
- 2. 21 villages stated in Gubernatorial Decree No. 878 Year 2018, please check the link here
- 3. RWs with the potential spread of new virus variant
- 4. Red and orange zone RTs, please check in the link <a href="here">here</a>

As he stated, the vaccination is in process and the expatriates should have SKTT (Certificate of Residence) or foreigner's ID card (KTP) to comply with the registration requirement. The application submission of SKTT or ID card can be processed at the Directorate General of Population and Civil Registration of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Indonesia (DUKCAPIL) Jakarta.

The requirements of SKTT application:

- Photocopy of Passport.
- Photocopy of ITAS.
- The old SKTT (for those who are extended).
- Lost item report from the Police (if it the lost).
- SKTT Head of Family for Newly Reporting Family Members.
- Application Letter from Sponsor/Guarantor.
- Stamped Power of Attorney if represented and Photocopy of ID Card (KTP) authorized.

The requirement of foreigner's ID card application:

- Photocopy of Passport
- Photocopy of Permanent Residency Visa (ITAP)
- Photocopy of Family members certificate (KK)
- Photocopy of Guarantor's KTP
- Photocopy of Marriage Certificate
- Photocopy of Birth Certificate
- Application Letter from Sponsor/Guarantor.
- Stamped Power of Attorney if represented and Photocopy of KTP authorized

In order to get these requirements fulfilled the new SKTT document, extension, and Exit Permit Only (EPO) can be printed by using the HVS white paper with the size A4-80 grams, please check the specific printing in the link here

While for the document that is allowed to use print user are only SKTT and EPO. While for the foreigner's ID card should be taken in Directorate General of Population and Civil Registration of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Indonesia (DUKCAPIL) Office.

To get the vaccination, the expatriates can go directly to the nearest health center (PUSKESMAS), hospital, and vaccination servicecenter. And/or the other locations, please check in the link here
