The Extension of Enforcement of Restrictions on Community Activities (PPKM) Java-Bali to August 9th 2021

President Joko Widodo holds the press conference on August 2nd, 2021 via the Official Youtube Channel of the Presidential Secretariat has announced the decision on the extension in the implementation of the Enforcement of Restrictions on Community Activities (PPKM) Java-Bali until **August 9th, 2021**.

The previous PPKM Level 4 (four) effect since July 26th, 2021 in Java-Bali had brought improvements in various aspects, ranging from positive cases of Covid-19, active cases, recovery rates, to the Bed Occupancy Rate (BOR) of the Covid-19 hospitals but to prevent the cases from going up the government has decided to extend the PPKM. The PPKM levels in Java-Bali are classified to Level 3 (three) and Level 4 (four) based on the improvements in every district/city (with detail as attached) since it's enforced, and Jakarta is currently still on the PPKM Level 4 (four).

The difference between PPKM Level 3 (three) and Level 4 (four) are as below,

PPKM Level 3 (three);

- 1. Non-essential work should work from home (WFH)
- 2. Essential work operates 100 percent divided into 2 shifts with strict health protocols
- 3. Shops or daily necessities market can open at 50 percent capacity and close at 20.00
- 4. People's markets other than daily needs can open with a capacity of 50 percent and close at 15.00
- 5. Shopping centers such as malls and plazas can open with a capacity of 25 percent and close at 17.00
- 6. Street vendors (PKL), barbershops and the like can be open until 20.00
- 7. Food stalls, street vendors, hawker stalls in open spaces may operate with a capacity of 25 percent and are open until 20.00. Meanwhile, diners who dine in are given a maximum time limit of 30 minutes.
- 8. The restaurant in a closed room only serves to take away/delivery
- 9. Teaching and learning activities are 100 percent online
- 10. Places of worship are opened with 25 percent capacity and strict health protocols.

PPKM Level 4 (four);

- 1. Non-essential work should work from home (WFH)
- 2. Essential work operates 50 percent divided into 1 shift and 100 percent WFO for critical with strict health protocols
- 3. Daily needs shops or markets can open at 50 percent capacity and close at 20.00
- 4. People's markets other than daily needs can open with a capacity of 25 percent and close at 15.00
- 5. Shopping centers such as malls and plazas are closed except pharmacies and drug stores
- 6. Street vendors (PKL), barbershops and the like can be open until 20.00
- 7. Food stalls, street vendors, food stalls in open spaces may operate with a maximum capacity of 3 people and open until 20.00. Meanwhile, diners who dine in are given a maximum time limit of 30 minutes.
- 8. The restaurant in a closed room only serves to take away/delivery.
- 9. Teaching and learning activities are 100 percent online.
- 10. Places of worship are prohibited from having congregational activities.

According to the President, there are three main pillars in handling the Covid-19 pandemic in Indonesia:

- 1. The speed of vaccination, especially in areas that are centers of economic activity.
- 2. The applicability health protocols in all components of society by implementing 3M;
- Memakai masker (Wear a mask)
- Mencuci tangan (Washing hands)
- Menjaga jarak dan menghindari kerumunan (Keep the distance and avoid the crowd)
- 3. Massive testing, tracing, isolation, and treatment activities, including maintaining BOR, adding centralized isolation facilities, and ensuring the availability of medicines and oxygen supply.
