The Extension of Enforcement of Restrictions on Community Activities (PPKM) Java-Bali to January 31st, 2022

According to the press conference held by Secretariat of the President of the Republic of Indonesia on January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The Coordinating Minister for Maritime Affairs and Investment, Luhut B. Pandjaitan announced the extension regarding the regulations of the implementation of Emergency Community Activity Restriction (PPKM) in Java-Bali. The government decided to extend the PPKM Java- Bali effective from January 25<sup>th</sup> until January 31<sup>st</sup> 2022 for one more week given the continued improvement in COVID-19 handling. Based on the assessment level and vaccination progress, the regions with first dose coverage lower than 50 percent will have their PPKM assessment increased by one level.

According to the Minister, the number of regencies/cities implementing PPKM level 1 has increased from 227 to 238 regions, regencies/cities categorized at level 2 have dropped from 148 to 138 regions, regencies/cities categorized at level 3 have dropped from 11 to 10 regions, and no more regencies/cities are at PPKM Level 4. Based on data as of 15 January, national active cases stood at 8,463 cases with a total of 194 cases or 23 percent from regions outside Java-Bali islands.

There are several adjustments on the regulations of PPKM in Java-Bali, include:

- 1. The Implementation of learning in education units can be done through limited face-to-face learning and/or distance learning.
- 2. The application of Working From Office (WFO) for the non-essential sector are:
  - A maximum of 25% for non-essential for employees who have been vaccinated in PPKM areas at level 3
  - A maximum of 50% for non-essential for employees who have been vaccinated in PPKM areas at level 2
  - A maximum of 75% for non-essential for employees who have been vaccinated in PPKM areas at level 1

As DKI Jakarta is in the Level 2, hence Jakarta is implementing 50% WFO for non-essential sectors

- 3. While for essential sectors, the maximum staff is 50% WFO for PPKM level 3, 75% for level 2, and 100% for level 1. All levels must optimize the PeduliLindungi application.
- 4. The implementation of shopping activities can operate with a maximum capacity of 75% until 21:00 local time and must use the PeduliLindungi application.
- 5. The implementation of activities in shopping centers / malls / trading centers is opened with a maximum capacity of 75% until 21:00 local time and must use the PeduliLindungi application.
- 6. The implementation of activities in places of worship is limited to a maximum of 75% capacity by implementing health protocols. Meanwhile, public facilities are allowed to be opened with a maximum capacity of 25% with health protocols.
- 7. Public transportation, mass transit, online taxis, rental vehicles, and aircraft are allowed with a maximum capacity of 100% and implementing strict health protocols.
- 8. For pharmacies and drug stores can be opened for 24 hours.

As emphasized before, the government still urges people to remain compliant with health protocols though the current positive cases of Covid-19 continue to decrease by always implementing 3M (wear a mask, washing hands, keep the distance and avoid the crowd) and 3T (testing, tracing, and treatment).
