The Extension of Enforcement of Restrictions on Community Activities (PPKM) Java-Bali to February 21st, 2022

According to the press conference held by Secretariat of the President of the Republic of Indonesia on Monday, February 14th, 2022, the Coordinating Minister for Maritime Affairs and Investment, Luhut B. Pandjaitan announced about the extension regarding the regulations of the implementation of Emergency Community Activity Restriction (PPKM) in Java-Bali. The government decided to extend the PPKM Java- Bali **from February 15th until February 21st 2022**.

The extension is affirmed in the Instruction of the Minister of Home Affairs (Inmendagri) No. 10 Year 2022 on the Enactment of Restrictions on Community Level 3, Level 2, and Level 1 Corona Virus Disease 2019 in Java and Bali.

There are a number of changes in Inmendagri No. 10 Year 2022. The first change is that the number of regions with PPKM Level 3 status in Java-Bali has increased from 41 regions to 66 regions.

The same thing also happened with the status of the regions on PPKM Level 2 from 57 regions to 58 regions. Meanwhile, for regions that are in PPKM Level 1 status, it has decreased from 30 regions to 4 regions.

Therefore, there are several adjustments on the regulations of PPKM in Java-Bali, include:

- 1. The implementation of activities in the non-essential sector is applied to:
 - Level 3: a maximum of 50% Work From Office (WFO) for employees that has been vaccinated and must use the PeduliLindungi application.
 - Level 2: a maximum of 75% Work From Office (WFO) for employees that has been vaccinated and must use the PeduliLindungi application.
 - Level 1: a maximum of 100% Work From Office (WFO) for employees that has been vaccinated and must use the PeduliLindungi application.

As DKI Jakarta is in the Level 3, hence Jakarta is implementing 50% WFO for non essential sectors.

- 2. The implementation of non-quarantine hospitality have a maximum capacity of 50% of visitors and must use the PeduliLindungi application for screening.
- 3. The implementation of shopping activities are limited to operating hours until 21:00 local time with a maximum visitor capacity of 60% and must use the PeduliLindungi application.
- 4. The implementation of activities in shopping centers / malls / trading centers are opened with a maximum capacity of 60% until 21:00 local time.
- 5. The implementation of activities in places of worship are limited to a maximum of 50% capacity by implementing health protocols. Meanwhile, public facilities are allowed to be opened with a maximum capacity of 50% with health protocols.
- 6. Public transportation, mass transit, online taxis, rental vehicles, and aircraft are allowed with a maximum capacity of 100% with strict health protocols.

As emphasized before, the government still urges people to remain compliant with health protocols though the current positive cases of Covid-19 continue to decrease by always implementing 3M (wear a mask, washing hands, keep the distance and avoid the crowd) and 3T (testing, tracing, and treatment).
