The Extension of Enforcement of Restrictions on Community Activities (PPKM) Java-Bali to January 3rd, 2022

According to the Minister's Press Statement regarding Limited Meeting (RaTas) released by Secretariat of the President of the Republic of Indonesia on December 13th 2021, Coordinating Minister for Maritime Affairs and Investment, Luhut Pandjaitan and Coordinating Minister of Economic Affairs, Airlangga Hartanto announced the extension of PPKM Java-Bali that lasts for 3 weeks effective from **December 14**th, **2021 to January 3**rd, **2022.**

It is reported that several improvements have occurred during the implementation of PPKM to this day, it can be seen on the fairly stable trend and the low level of Covid-19 cases nationally. As per December 11th 2021, there are only 10 from the total of 128 districts/cities in Level 3, 13 districts/cities in Level 1 while 4 districts/cities are in Level 2. It means that each district/cities applies a different level of PPKM and not simultaneously in Level 3 as previously planned by the government.

There are several updates regarding the extensions of PPKM Java-Bali and also in preventing the spread of Omicron variants that will be carried out by the government in referring to Inmendagri No. 66 Year 2021, including:

- 1. The start of vaccination for children aged 6 to 11 years old with SINOVAC has been approved by the National Agency of Drug and Food Control (BPOM).
- 2. The quarantine period obligation for 10 days for the foreigners (WNA) and the Indonesian Citizens (WNI) arriving in Indonesia with provisions according to Inmendagri No. 66 Year 2021.

Furthermore, Minister Luhut gave several guidance to the public on PPKM during Christmas and New Year Holiday (Nataru) including:

- 1. To remains in the country to avoid the transmission of the new variant of Covid-19 virus except for really urgent matters to avoid the spread of new variants of the virus.
- 2. To enjoy domestic tourist attractions during Christmas and New Year Holiday (Nataru) rather than going to other countries.
- 3. To conduct a second dose of vaccine for domestic long-travelers with only Rapid Antigen Test within 1x24 hours before departure.
