Update on Revocation of the Health Insurance Ownership Proof as Requirement for Foreigners to Enter Indonesia, Effective from June 8th, 2022

The COVID-19 of Handling Task Force issued an Addendum for Circular Letter No. 19 Year 2022 Concerning Health Protocol for International Travel During COVID-19 Pandemic. This Addendum is effective from June 8th, 2022.

This circular letter amends the regulation for attaching proof of COVID-19 health insurance ownership for Foreigners (WNA) Overseas Travelers (PPLN) that was that previously required the foreigners to attach proof of COVID-19 health insurance ownership.

There are several highlighted points in this regulation, namely:

- 1. All foreigners who will enter the territory of the Republic of Indonesia shall adjust the general travel requirements to be allowed to enter the territory of Indonesia, which include the COVID-19 vaccination certificate and the use of PeduliLindungi application.
- Foreign travellers are not required to show a negative RT-PCR test result in which samples.
- 3. All foreign travellers are allowed to enter the territory of Indonesia through official entry points List of the entry points, please check here.
- 4. Upon arrival at the entry points, foreign travellers must undergo a COVID-19 symptom check.
- 5. Quarantine is no longer required for those who have been fully vaccinated. Therefore, those who haven't been vaccinated are still required to have a quarantine period of 5 days.
- 6. The provision for showing a COVID-19 vaccination certificate (physical or digital) is excluded for all foreign travellers with foreigners with a diplomatic passports or those who undergo official duty, foreigners who only intend to transit in Indonesia, minors under 18 years old, and those who have a special health condition or has been declared COVID-19 free.
