

On September 20<sup>th</sup> 2022, the Ministry of Law and Human Rights COVID-19 Task Force issued a Circular Letter (SE) of the Director of Immigration No. IMI-0702.GR.01.01 Year 2022 concerning Immigration Policy to Simplify the Bureaucracy, Simplify and Accelerate Residence Permit Services to Support the Policy to Increase Foreign Investment in the Country. This regulation is effective from **September 20<sup>th</sup> 2022**.

The Circular Letter aims to Simplify Bureaucracy, and Accelerate Stay Permit Services is also a follow-up to the instructions of the President of the Republic of Indonesia to provide convenience for Immigration Stay Permit services in order to increase foreign investment in Indonesia and increase the arrival of foreign tourists.

Furthermore, this regulation stipulates the simplification of the residence permit service process which was previously processed **for 14 days to only 2 days**. There is no more field supervision/checking in the Immigration Stay Permit service business process, later field supervision/checking can be carried out, if necessary, after the Stay Permit is issued.
