Summary of Indonesia's Horticulture Statistic 2022

The Central Bureau of Statistics (Badan Pusat Statistik/BPS) published the Statistic of Horticulture 2022 on 9 June 2023 which highlights all the production data of Indonesia's horticulture commodities. The statistic was categorized into seasonal vegetables, annual seasonal fruits, medical plants, and ornamental plants with the detail as follows:

1. Seasonal Vegetables

As a producer of seasonal vegetables such as shallots, garlics, big chilies, cayenne peppers, potatoes, tomatoes, and carrots. In 2022, shallots productions decreased by 1,11%, reaching 1.98 million tons, while garlic productions decreased by 32,18%, reaching 30.58 thousand tons. Big chili production increased by 8,47% to 1.48 million tons, cayenne pepper production increased by 11,4% to 1.54 million tons, potato production increased by 10,5% to 1.50 million tons, tomato production increased by 4,88% to 1.17 million tons, and carrot production increased by 2,48% to 737.97 thousand tons.

2. Annual Seasonal Fruits

Besides seasonal vegetables, Indonesia also produced many annual seasonal fruits. In 2022, banana production in Indonesia increased by 5,77% to reach 9.24 million tons. Durians production saw a significant growth of 16,94%, reaching 1.58 million tons. Oranges production increased by 6,81% to reach 2.68 million tons. Mangoes production rose by 16,70% to reach 3.31 million tons. Pineapples production saw a growth of 10,99% to reach 3.2 million tons. Mangosteens production increased by 13,07% to reach 343.66 thousand tons.

3. Medical Plants

There are also several categories for medical plants including turmeric, java turmeric, and ginger. In 2022, Java turmeric production decreased by 12,96% to reach 28.10 thousand tons, along with a decline in the harvested area by 33,69% to 1.3 thousand hectares. Ginger production also experienced a decline of 19,46% to reach 247.45 thousand tons along with a slight decrease in harvested area by 1,89% to 10.40 thousand hectares. However, turmeric production experienced an increase of 6,32% to reach 196.5 thousand tons along with a growth in harvested area by 2,75% to 7.56 thousand hectares.

4. Ornamental Plants

Indonesia is also a significant producer of ornamental plants, particularly orchids and chrysanthemums. In 2022, orchid production reached 6.79 million stalks. Chrysanthemum production in 2022 increased by 14,67% to reach 394.02 million stalks along with the harvested area decreased by 5,81% to 666.06 hectares.
