Policy on Limiting the Flow of People in Handling Covid-19 by Coordinating Ministry for Maritime and Investment Affairs and Ministry of Transportation

The Coordinating Ministry for Maritime and Investment Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia, Gen. Army (Purn.) Luhut Binsar Pandjaitan released a "Policy on Limiting the Flow of People in Handling Covid-19". The Minister explains the projection of Covid-19 globally alongside with the case brought from Ping An Group (China) and some facts within the document to learned in handling Covid-19 from other countries.

Due to the statistic related to homecoming "mudik" flow, the Minister gave some regional quarantine scale options starting from the Jakarta, Bogor, Depok, Tangerang and Bekasi (Jabodetabek) region scale up to whole Java island scale alongside the scheme, benefits, and disadvantages. And the Minister gave some recommendations toward the pandemic in various sectors for the government, other ministries, and institutions.

The policy to limit the flow of the people is supported by circular letter on Ministry of Transportation No.21 year 2020 on large scale social limitations (PSBB) and as declared by the President of Indonesia, Ir. H. Joko Widodo that stipulated a Presidential Decree and Government Regulations on the last 31 March 2020. The policy is also supported by the Ministry of Transportation on the circular letter SE.5 BPTJ 2020 which limits the flow of public and private transportation to limit the flow of people within Jakarta, Bogor, Depok, Tangerang and Bekasi (Jabodetabek) region.
