## Ministry of Transportation Regulation No. 25/2020 on Transportation Control During Mudik (Homecoming) 2020 in Handling the Spread of the Corona Virus 2019 (Covid-19)

On 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2020, the Minister of Transportation, Budi Karya Sumadi stipulated a regulation No. 25/2020 on transportation control during Mudik (homecoming) 2020 in handling the spread of the corona virus 2019 (Covid-19).

Based on this regulation, there will be restrictions on the use of passenger transportation. Temporary prohibitions on the use of transportation referred to are:

- a. Land transportation;
- b. Rail transportation;
- c. Water transportation; and
- d. Air Transport.

This prohibition applies on **April 24<sup>th</sup> 2020 until May 31<sup>st</sup> 2020**. And this prohibition period can be extended until further notice.

The categorized land transportation are:

- a. Public motor vehicles, with types of buses and cars for passenger;
- b. Individual motorized vehicles, with the type of cars, bus, and motorbikes;
- c. Ferries;
- d. River and lake transport vessels.

The categorized Rail Transportation are:

- a. Intercity train travel; and
- b. Urban train travel (Commuter Line)

The categorized Ferries Transportation are:

- a. The operation of passenger ships serving passengers for Mudik in one province, district or sub-district that applies the PSBB; and
- b. Shipping between provinces, districts or sub-districts with the provisions the port of origin, stopover, or destination is an area that applies the PSBB

The categorized Air Transportation is:

Prohibition on every citizen traveling within the country through airports to and from areas designated as PSBB as "red zones" of corona virus 2019 (covid-19) disease spread

The Exception for Air Transportations are:

- a. The President of the Republic of Indonesia high institution and state guests;
- b. Operations of embassies, consulates general, and foreign consulates as well as representatives of international organizations in Indonesia;
- c. Special flight operations repatriation (repatriation flight) which repatriate's Indonesian citizens and foreign nationals based on the regulations;
- d. Law enforcement, order and operational operations;
- e. Cargo transport operations; and
- f. Other operations based on the permission of the Director General of Civil Aviation.

In addition, aircraft crew carrying out cargo transportation activities must have a **health certificate issued by a health facility doctor or the Airport Health Office (KKP)** at the Airport.

The objectives of restrictions apply to transportation in and out of "red zone" areas with high levels of Covid-19 infection or areas where PSBB is applied.
